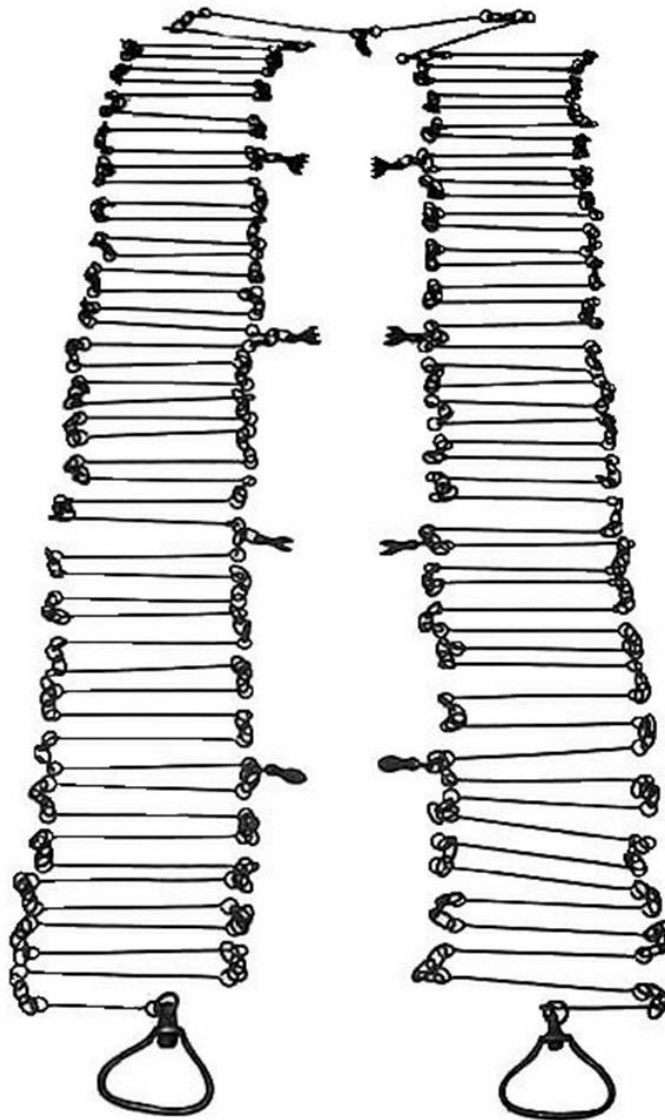
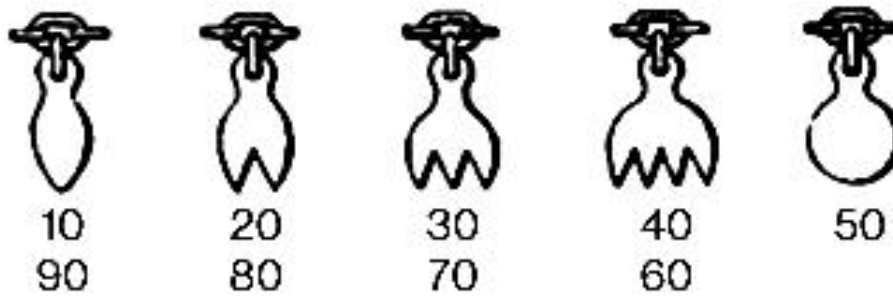


Gunter's Chain

Tallies every 10 links

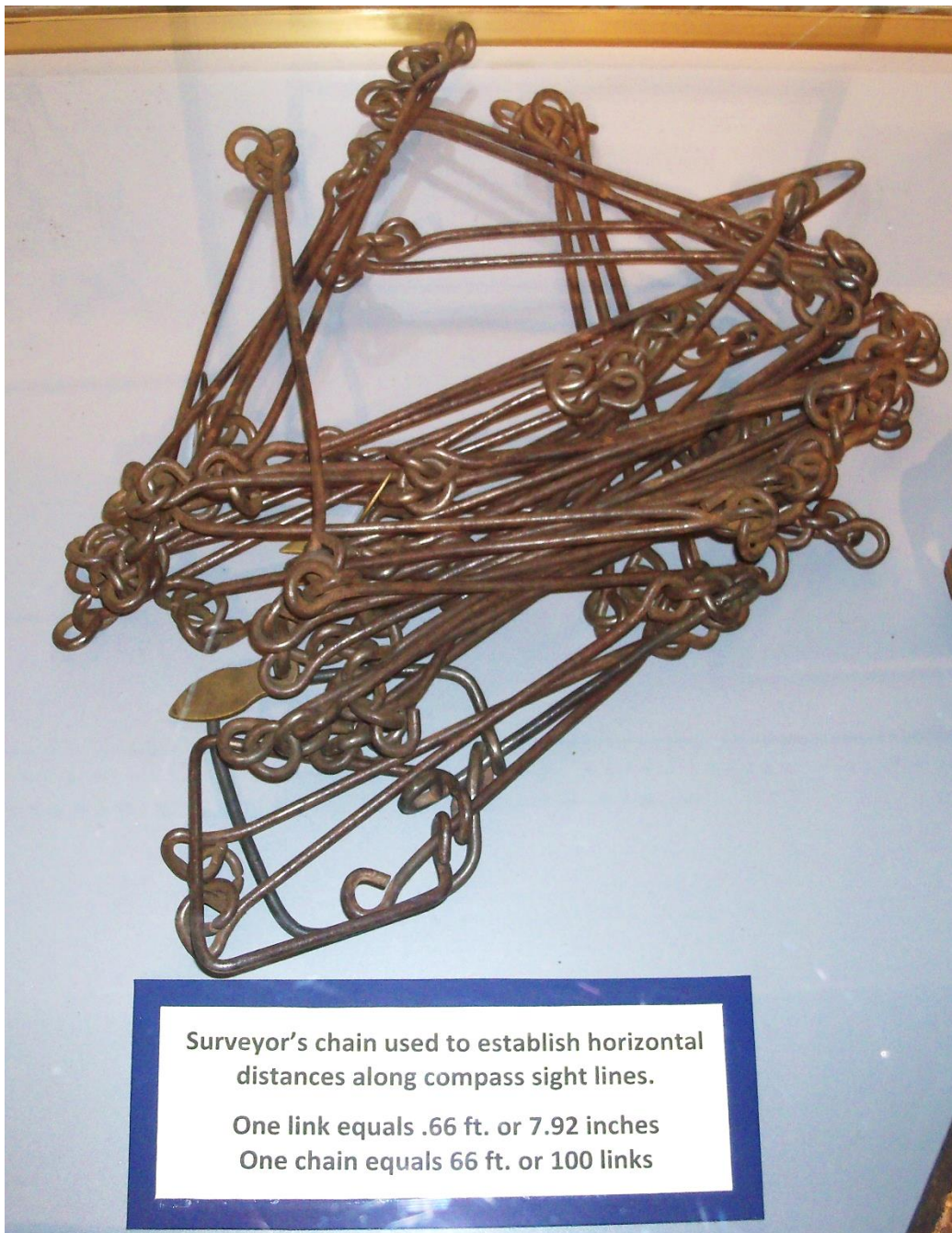


This is a common design for the tallies and count of links where they appear on a Chain:



Gunter's Chain

Used to measure before surveyors had tape measures.
Metal gives accuracy as it does not stretch or break easily.
However, if a link did break it could be easily repaired.

100 metal links

One link = 0.66 feet, about 7.92 inches or 20.12 cm
One Chain is 66 feet or 22 yards, roughly 20.12 metres
